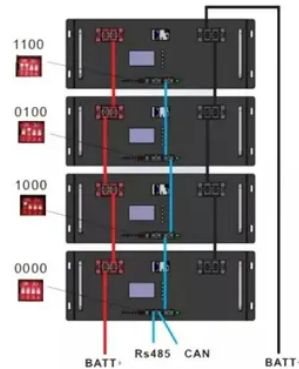




Are the electromagnetic waves of communication base stations long

This unique property allows radio waves to travel vast distances and penetrate obstacles, making them ideal for long-range communication. Since radio waves are the lowest frequency category of electromagnetic waves, there is no lower limit to the frequency of radio waves. The information is imposed on the electromagnetic carrier wave as amplitude modulation (AM) or as frequency modulation (FM) or in digital form (pulse).
