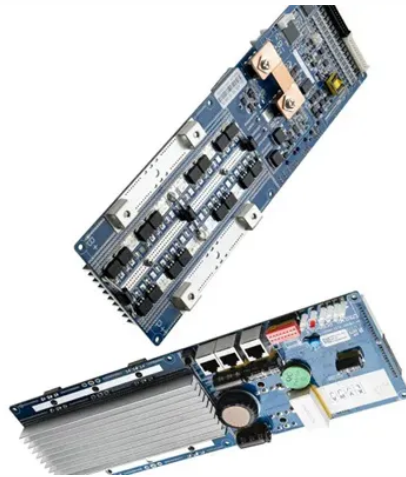




Dominican republic nico electricity safety



Overview

The country's main power plants abruptly stopped supplying energy before noon, triggering shutdowns across all other generating units. The outage halted traffic, disrupted public transport, and forced businesses to close. By mid-afternoon, the grid had been restored to nearly 30% of. The Dominican Institute of Telecommunications (Indotel), the National District Mayor's Office (ADN), and the Unified Council of Electricity Distribution Companies (CUED) signed a cooperation agreement to remove obsolete overhead wiring and reorganize infrastructure that negatively affects urban. The new regulation requires battery projects to deliver fast frequency response, black start and ramp-rate control. The Superintendence of Electricity plans further measures in 2025–2026 to expand the regulatory framework. The Dominican Republic has taken a decisive step in regulating battery.
