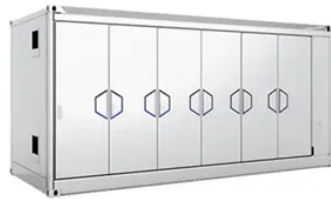




East timor energy storage policy



Overview

Portable storage units will enable electricity access in areas without grid infrastructure, supporting schools and medical. East Timor is embarking on a major clean energy milestone with the construction of its first large-scale solar power plant in 2026. The 72 MW project in Manatuto, developed jointly by Japan's Itochu Corp and France's EDF, will also feature a 36 MW battery energy storage system to ensure stable and. Will Timor-Leste's first solar power project integrate with a battery energy storage system?

In a landmark moment for Timor-Leste's energy future, a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) has been officially signed for the country's first-ever solar power project integrated with a Battery Energy Storage. Global law firm DLA Piper, as part of an advisory team led by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) has advised Eletricidade de Timor-Leste (EDTL) on a power purchase agreement with a consortium comprised of Électricité de France and Itochu for the development of Timor-Leste's first utility-scale solar. What renewable sources will power the storage systems?
