



Solar power generation at US military bases



Overview

From forward operating bases to mobile command centers, solar power brings a distinct edge to military operations. Let's explore how this technology transforms tactical capabilities on the ground. Along with the solar installation, Fort Polk is installing more than 3,600 ground-source heat pumps at Fort Polk's homes, office space and neighborhood centers. The upgrades are expected to reduce electricity use by 31%, or 12,794 MWh per year, saving nearly \$40 million. This shift represents a strategic decision reshaping. The military's demand for inexpensive, hard-to-disable power for its constellation of bases has driven it to collaborate with civilian contractors in exploring a new generation of "off the shelf" clean tech.
