



Solar power generation companies closed down



Overview

Several notable solar companies serving Minnesota and Wisconsin customers have gone out of business, including Pink Energy, SunPower, and ADT Solar. These closures have left homeowners facing stalled projects, unmet warranty claims, and uncertainty about future support. However, 2024 has brought immense challenges, with higher interest rates, tighter financing, and adverse policy shifts in key states contributing to over 100 solar bankruptcies based on our industry data, a number unseen before in our almost 20 years in the solar sector. But 2024 has marked a sharp turn. " Much of the rooftop solar industry is in liquidation mode, and now the central station "utility scale" solar industry is in trouble. Expect more of the same in the next. Bankruptcy filings in the US solar sector have continued in 2025 amid a confluence of headwinds. US solar and storage developer Pine Gate Renewables filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection in November, joining other major companies that went under earlier this year, including residential solar.
