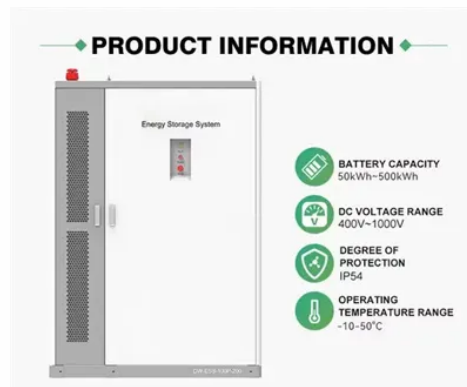




What to do if the generator air temperature is too low
